

# Waste Management Bulky Item Collection Event

Auburn's annual **RESIDENTIAL BULKY ITEM COLLECTION** is a once-a-year opportunity to clean house and get rid of your **bulky items** that are non-hazardous, non-liquid, and non-reusable at the curb or alley.

**ONE DAY ONLY** on your **GARBAGE** collection day as follows:

## **EVEN** Recycle Schedule Customers:

## **ODD** Recycle Schedule Customers:

Bulky Item Collection is on your garbage day the week of

**April 11–15, 2016**

## Who can participate?

- Residents who live in a single-family home, duplex or mobile home park within the Auburn City limits.
- Residents who are a customer of Waste Management.

*Apartments (3 or more units) and businesses are NOT included in the Bulky Item Collection program.*

## COLLECTION GUIDELINES

### How do I prepare materials for collection?

1. Place unusable **BULKY** household items by your garbage container for pickup **by 7 a.m.** on your garbage collection day.
2. Be sure items are not blocking garbage or compostables containers.
3. **LIMITED to ONE of each type of item** per household.
4. **NO** small or miscellaneous items, garbage, yard waste or household hazardous waste.
5. **NO** wood or lumber, carpet/padding, TVs, construction materials or electronics.
6. Remove all doors on refrigerators and freezers.
7. **Empty & drain** of all fluids except for refrigerators and freezers (including motor oil, gasoline, hydraulic fluids, etc.).
8. **PUT OUT AT YOUR OWN RISK.** Keep items not meant for pickup away from bulky items. The City of Auburn and Waste Management cannot be responsible for items picked up that were not meant for the Bulky Item Collection.
9. Regular garbage and compostable collection will be picked up on the normal schedule during Bulky Item Collection week.

### What if my items were not picked up?

1. The Bulky Item Collection driver will leave an **"OOPS TAG"** for items not accepted. Please remove these items from the curbside or alley.
2. If there is **NO "OOPS TAG"** and your items have not been picked up **by 7 p.m.**, \*call the City of Auburn within 24 hours at 253-931-3038, option #2 to report a missed pickup.  
*\* Mobile Home Park Property Manager/Owner must call to report a missed pick up for residents.*
