# YARD & FOOD WASTE

#### FOOD SCRAPS AND LEFTOVERS

Meat, fish, dairy, fruit, vegetables, shells, bones, pasta, rice, eggshells, nutshells, bread, grains and leftovers.



### FOOD-SOILED PAPER

Coffee grounds and filters, soiled paper bags, kitchen paper towels, paper napkins, pizza boxes. No Plastic lined paper products



### PLANTS, FLOWERS AND YARD TRIMMINGS

Plants and flowers, landscape vegetation, vegetative garden waste. windfall fruit, iack-o-lanterns and brush, branches less than 4 inches thick and 4 feet long, sod (no more than 60 lbs.)



You can set out extra vard waste on collection day for a charge. Set out extras in a kraft paper bag. 32-gallon personal can (limit 65 lbs) or bundle tied with twine (4'x2' limit). Yard waste collection is available by subscription in designated areas.

### Please place containers at the curb by 6:00 a.m.

- Place containers two (2) feet apart with lids opening towards street.
- · Place containers at least three (3) feet from cars, trees, and mailboxes,
- · Please take containers in as soon as possible after collection
