

Recycling - accepted for free when properly prepared and disposed of.

- **Cooking Oil** - Now accepting clean cooking oil in clear containers for recycle.
- **Container Glass** – Separate by color: Green, Clear, and Brown ONLY - RINSED & LIDS REMOVED. No windows, mirrors, cookware, stemware, light bulbs, ceramics, etc.
- **Corrugated Cardboard** – Flattened Corrugated Cardboard
- **Comingled Recycle** - Magazines, Brown Paper Bags, mail, envelopes, tin, steel, & aluminum cans, plastic bottles and tubs. (No motor oil or hazardous material containers. No wax or plastic coated or food contaminated product. Also, no plastic utensils, paper plates, towels, napkins, etc.) All items MUST be cleaned.
- **Newspaper** – Newspaper and what comes in the newspaper only.
- **Rigid Plastic** – Five gallon buckets, plastic children’s toys (must have the battery removed), pools, patio chairs, plastic pots, etc.
- **Scrap Metal** – Non CFC containing appliances, metal doors, bicycles, lawnmowers, barbeques, etc. (All liquids must be removed from motors.)
- **E-scrap** -TV’s, laptops, computers, monitors & cables.
- **Motor Oil** – Motor oil ONLY (NO PEANUT OR COOKING OIL).
- **Carpet Pad** – “multi fleck” recyclable pad only
- **Batteries** – Lead acid automotive, motorcycle, golf cart, etc.
- **Wire** – Christmas lights, extension cords, household wiring, etc.

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

Any liquids (other than Motor Oil – put in the designated area), hazardous waste, asbestos, paint, medical or pathological waste, , contaminated soil, materials with PCB’s, propane tanks, gas cylinders, fire extinguishers, explosives, ammunition, or wood treated with Creosote.

Materials accepted include paint, batteries, pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, stains, thinners, solvents, cleaners, automotive fluids, spa and pool chemicals, hobby and art chemicals, propane tanks, unwanted medication, sharps (lancets, syringes, needles) and mercury-containing products such as fluorescent light bulbs/tubes and old thermometers.

A \$5 fee will be charged for the first 35 gallons and each additional 35 gallons delivered. Additional charges apply for containers larger than 10 gallons. No fee for exterior and interior latex and oil paints and other architectural paints waste covered under Oregon PaintCare program (paintcare.org).
