

City of Kennewick – Residential WM Customers Free Disposal Program

Drop Off Program Instructions

For those times when you have more waste than your garbage cart can handle, the City of Kennewick's Free Disposal Program is your solution. Free trips to the WM Kennewick Transfer Station, 2627 S. Ely Street!

Q: Who Can Participate?

- City of Kennewick residents who subscribe to WM garbage collection service and have an account in good standing.
- Apartment and rental homes are not eligible unless resident specifically pays for garbage service with name on the account and matching state issued I.D. at time of use.

Q: Are loaded trailers ok?

- Standard pickup trucks, small utility trailers or cars only.
- No, large trailers, moving trucks or dump trucks.
- Materials must fit in a standard pickup truck bed.
- Limit per trip is one level standard pickup truck load 2.5 yards.
- Loads over 2.5 yards will be charged standard rates or use two (2) trips allocations

Q: Can I give my free trips to other residents or my lawncare company?

 No. Free disposal trips are not transferable to landscaper, friends or family living outside customer's residence. Customer's name and address on WM account must match their state-issued ID at time of use.

Q: How many trips are allowed?

• Six (6) trips per calendar year for City of Kennewick WM residential customers – see acceptable items list

BELOW ITEMS ACCEPTED AT NO CHARGE FOR COUPON PROGRAM

- Non-reusable household junk
- Washers
- Dryers
- Water heaters
- Stoves
- Dishwashers
- Small appliances

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR A CHARGE (NOT PART OF COUPON PROGRAM)

- Concrete*
- Dry wall
- Refrigerators, freezers, A/C's*
- Roofing
- Insulation
- All flooring (tile, carpet, vinyl, and wood)
- Tree stumps
- Lumber, wood, treated wood
- Construction and demolition material
- Asphalt
- Doors, door frames, windows
- Masonry
- Siding
- Structural metal
- Dirt, rocks, sand, or in-fill
- Commercially generated waste

ITEMS ACCEPTABLED FOR DROP OFF RECYCLING (IF SEPARATED)

- Motor Oil & Cooking Oil
- Antifreeze
- Cardboard
- Computers & TV's*

*Please donate reusable items to a local charity or recycle facility. For more disposal options go to 1800recycle.wa.gov or call 1-800-RECYCLE.

- Lawn mowers (must be free of fuel and oil)
- Passenger car or motorcycle tires <u>limit 2</u>
- Furniture*
- Toilets & sinks
- Mattresses 1 set per trip
- Power tools
- Yard debris, cut grass, leaves, branches, organic waste

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Automotive waste
- Any liquid
- Running gears
- Thermometers
- Mercury switches
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Thermostats
- Car body parts
- Car batteries
- Hazardous, medical, or special waste

- Paper and magazines
- Tin & aluminum cans
- Plastic water bottles & milk jugs
