COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Please follow these guidelines to ensure collection.

Place carts at the curb by 6 am.

- Two (2) feet apart with lids opening toward street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences and utility boxes
- Wheels as close to the curb as possible
- Please remove carts as soon as possible after collection





GARBAGE

Charges are based on cart size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your cart with the lid completely closed.

- Weight limit 32/35-gallon/65 lbs for your collector's safety
- Bag and tie garbage. Shopping bags work well
- Double bag pet litter, packing pellets and cold ashes

INCLEMENT WEATHER GUIDELINES

- Up to twice the regular amount of garbage, recycling, and compost will be collected at no additional charge on your next regularly scheduled collection day. Please note recycle and compost are collected every other week.
- In the event of two successive weather delays, make-up collection will be made on the next possible day.
- Credits will not be issued for delayed collection due to inclement weather
