PUT THESE ITEMS IN YOUR RECYCLING CONTAINER
ITEMS MUST BE CLEAN, DRY, AND EMPTY



Paper and Flattened Cardboard



Paper Cups and Cartons



Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Cups and Tubs



Glass Bottles and Jars



Metal Cans



A recycling dumpster up to twice the volume of your garbage dumpster is included at no additional charge.

EXAMPLE:

Garbage service level:
1 yard



Included recycling service level:
2 yards

Everything you put in your recycling cart should be:



Clean

Give food containers a quick rinse.



Dry

Don't leave cardboard out in the rain.
Keep cart lid closed.



Empty

Pour out liquid.
Scrape out food.
