

RECYCLING

DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES. PLACE LOOSE IN CART.

Contamination charges may be applied if your recycling cart contains non-recyclable items.

Clean paper & cardboard



Glass bottles and jars

No caps or lids



Metal cans



NO PLASTIC BAGS

Plastic bottles, jugs & tubs

No caps or lids



TIP: Ignore the number on plastic containers, instead recycle only these shapes

Please don't leave any extra recyclables in cardboard boxes out in the rain. Place next to your cart on the morning of your collection day.

Extra Recycling:

Put extra recycling in cardboard boxes (limit 3'x3'x3'), or a 32-gallon can with handles marked "recycling".

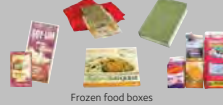
Non-recyclable plastic

Extra Garbage:

Garbage charges are based on container size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.



Garbage Collection Tips

- Please bag all garbage.
- Double bag pet waste, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust, and cold ashes.

NO PLASTIC BAGS

Plants, flowers and yard trimmings

Branches must be no larger than 4 inches in diameter and cut into 4 foot or smaller sections.



Extra Yard Waste:

There is a charge for extra yard waste that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.

- Put extra yard waste only in:
- Cans with handles
(32 gal., 65 lb. limit)
 - Label cans "Yard"
 - Bundle tied with twine
(4'x2' limit)
 - Paper leaf bags



Food Scrap Collection Tips:

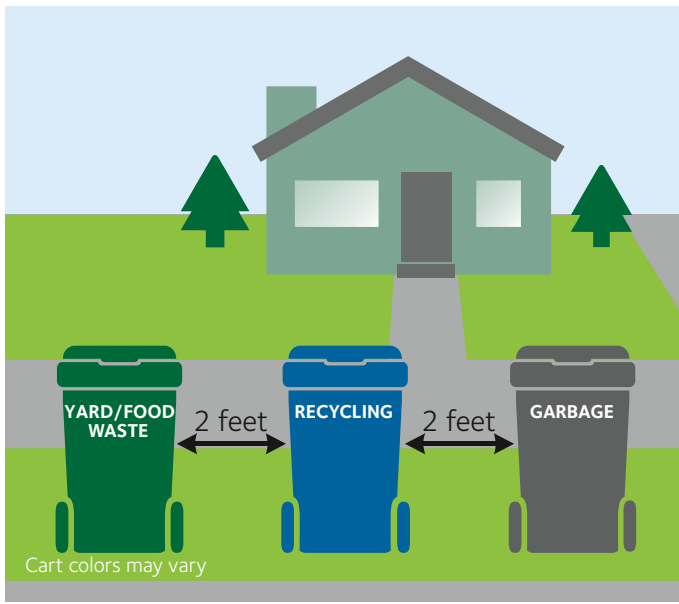
1. Collect kitchen food scraps in:
 - Colander or strainer
 - Paper grocery bag
 - Reusable plastic, metal or ceramic containers
2. Empty your container into yard/food cart frequently.
3. Layer food scraps with yard waste or newspaper to absorb liquids.

Please place containers at the curb by 6 a.m.

- Two (2) feet apart with lids opening towards the street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes
- Wheels as close to the curb as possible

Please remove containers as soon as possible after collection.

WHY recycle?

- Plastic bottles** can turn into clothing
- Aluminum cans** can turn into new ones in 60 days
- Today's news** can become a new cereal box

How to recycle:

- Recycle bottles, cans and paper products only
- Keep items clean and dry
- No plastic bags

Three Basic Rules

Knowing these rules and putting them into practice will help you recycle more efficiently. And it will help to ensure everything that makes it into the bin finds a second life

RULE 1
Recycle bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.

RULE 2
Keep food and liquid out of your recycling.

RULE 3
No loose plastic bags and no bagged recyclables.
