

# YARD DEBRIS GUIDELINES

The following items go in your yard debris cart:



## Yard Trimmings








Branches • Houseplants • Garden vegetation  
Grass and leaves • Weeds and prunings  
Undecorated holiday trees

## Extra Yard Debris

Put extra trimmings that don't fit in your cart in one of these:

- **32-gallon cans with handles + lids**  
(60lb limit) Fill loosely so cans empty easily
- **Kraft paper yard bags**
- **Bundle extra branches** (4x2x2 ft. limit)
- **DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS**

## KEEP OUT of Yard Debris

-  No food
-  No diapers
-  No pet waste/litter
-  No plastic bags
-  No metal
-  No cooking oils
-  No glass
-  No hoses
-  No tarps
-  No plastic twine

Label cans or paper bags "Yard" and put them at least 3 feet from Yard Debris Cart.
