



WOOD VILLAGE SPRING CLEAN UP DAY!

Saturday, May 15th, 2010



This is the ninth year that Wood Village is offering the "bulky waste" curbside pick up for items you no longer want or need.

Residents must take their tree prunings, yard debris, scrap metal, glass, newspaper, and other recyclables to the Troutdale Transfer Station located at 869 NW Eastwind Drive where they will be assisted with unloading their materials between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. (take 223rd Ave. north, turn east on Marine Drive, go 1.2 miles and turn right on Eastwind Drive.)

Waste Management will be picking up all "bulky waste" (listed below in the YES column) that is placed by the **curb no later than 6 a.m. on Saturday, May 15th**. Make sure your items are **at the curb or they will not be picked up**. Items that will **NOT** be picked up are listed under the **NO** column. The 3rd column lists the materials that will be accepted at the Troutdale Transfer Station (proof of residency will be required).

All Mobile Home Parks will be provided with a drop box on-site for their Bulky Waste items. Residents are asked to place ALL their Bulky Waste items into the drop boxes.

We are looking for volunteers to lend a hand to those who may need assistance getting their items to the curb (elderly, handicapped, sick, overwhelmed, as well as those lacking the resources). If you need help, you must call City Hall by Wednesday, May 8th for arrangements, or if you would like to volunteer, please phone Marie at City Hall at 503-489-6859.
