Draw a line from the throw-away item to something that can be used over and over again.

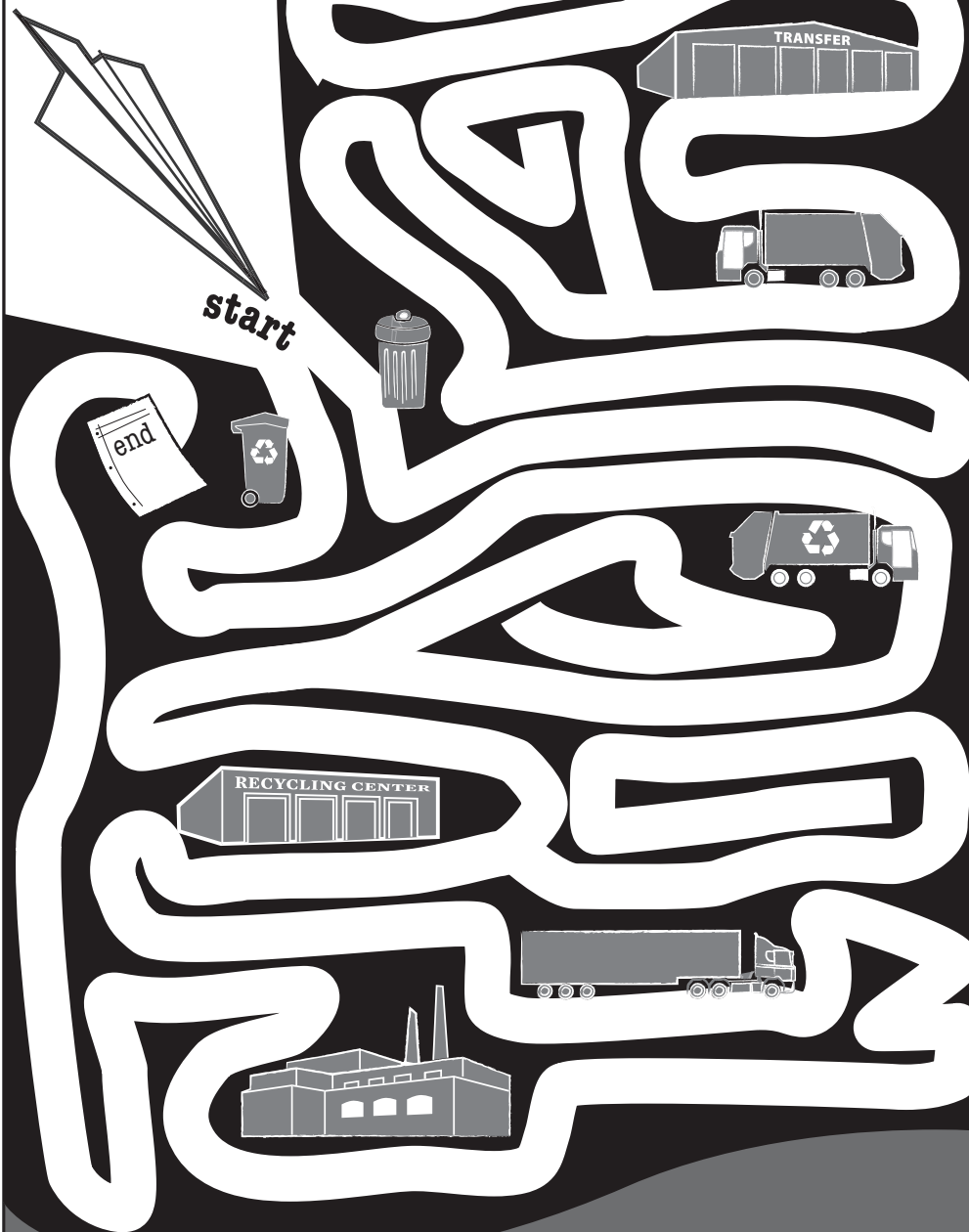
