Please do not bag. Place these loose items in your recycling cart. Recyclables should be **empty, clean & loose**.

**Clean Metal\***

\*Normandy Park accepts all clean aluminum cans, tin cans, tin lids larger than 3", trays, pie tins, and food containers.

Scrap Metal: All ferrous and non-ferrous scrap metal, free of wood, rubber, and other contaminants. Small items less than 2'x2' and 35 lbs. and with less than 5% non-metal parts are acceptable in Recycle cart.

## Special Recycling:

### Household Batteries:

All alkaline, button, and rechargeable batteries. Place in separate, sealed clear bags and set on top of recycling cart.











**Used Motor Oil:** Place in screw-top plastic jugs, labeled with the customer address and placed next to

the recycling cart. Up to three (3) gallons per week that is free from contaminants.
