Clean Paper and Cardboard

Newspaper, corrugated cardboard, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, junk mail, printer paper, paper boxes (cereal etc.), non-coated paper products



FLATTEN & CUT CARDBOARD TO FIT INTO THE CART WITH THE LID SHUT



Clean, Empty Glass Bottles and Jars
