## **KEEP OUT of Your Yard Debris**

- 🛕 Plastic bags
- Glass
- 🛕 Diapers
- Pet waste
- 🛕 Tarps

- A Hoses
- Liquids
- A Fats, Oils or Grease
- A Dirt or Rocks
- ▲ Sod

## **Compost Tips:**

- In your kitchen, gather food scraps in a colander or strainer, reusable container with a lid or a paper bag.
- Empty into your outdoor yard/food cart frequently.
- Layer food scraps with yard waste or newspaper to absorb liquids.

## **Extra Yard Waste:**

There is a charge for extra yard waste that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.

Put extra yard waste only in:

- · Cans with handles (35 gal., 70 lb. limit)
- Label cans "Yard"
- · Bundle tied with twine (4'x2' limit)
- · Paper leaf bags
