Have glass to recycle? **Do not place it in your recycling cart.** Take it to one of the **Residential Recycling and Household Hazardous Waste drop off locations listed.** These transfer station facilities accept recycling (including glass) and household hazardous waste at no extra cost.

## **Extra Recycling:**

Place extra recyclables in a bin or cardboard box at the curb next to your recycling cart. There is a charge for extra recycling.
