# Extra Recycling

### Please note that there is a charge for extra recycling.

If you have additional recyclables beyond your cart's capacity, you can place them in clear plastic recycling bins or cardboard boxes, with a size limit of 3' x 3' x 3'. For cardboard, cut it down into 2' x 2' pieces and bundle it next to your recycling cart. Set out all extra recyclables on your normal collection day, placing them adjacent to your primary recycling cart.

If you frequently have excess recyclables, consider adding a second cart to your service for more convenient disposal



Kittitas County is under an apple maggot quarantine. Waste from your yard, garden or agricultural property cannot leave the county. It is not allowed in garbage or recycling curbside carts. Please compost it on your own property, take it to a Kittitas County transfer station or subscribe to yard debris collection service.


