What can I put in the WM Textile Recycling cart?



We Accept:

- ✓ clothing
- ✓ household linens
- ✓ towels
- ✓ stained, ripped or torn items



We do not accept:

- ✓ shoes
- ✓ belts
- ✓ hats
- ✓ non-fabric accessories
- ✓ paint-soiled clothing

Why recycle textiles?



Right now, more than 85% of used textiles end up in landfills.

The average U.S. citizen throws away 70–80 pounds of clothing and other textiles every year. Textiles is the fastest growing waste stream in the country.

Recycling textiles ensures that the labor and resources that go into producing our clothing and linens isn't wasted. Fibers are recovered and turned into new products, growing our economy and reducing environmental impacts.

How do I participate?

WM is working with the property manager on site to launch this program at your apartment or condo. To participate, locate the textile collection container and conveniently dispose of unwanted household textiles. It's a simple, no stress way to be sustainable!
