Attention Property Managers! You can now offer textile recycling at your apartment and condominium properties at no charge



WM Textile Recycling is a pilot collection program that makes it easy for apartment and condo residents to recycle textiles from home.

If you manage a property located within unincorporated Snohomish County, it's easy to get started! WM will deliver a brand new container with signage that shows exactly what's accepted, so it's clear and convenient for everyone. On your scheduled date, WM will show up, empty it, and take the contents away for recycling.

Why are property managers excited?

- Reduced dumpster overflow. Clothing, bedding and other textiles can cause garbage containers to fill up quickly, leading to more pickups and potential overflows. These space-hogging items now have their own container!
- **Greener operations.** Most textiles can be processed and reused, conserving natural resources and reducing greenhouse gas emissions. This program offers one more way for you and your tenants to help ensure a sustainable future for Washington.
- **Happier residents.** A growing majority of Washingtonians value sustainability at home, at work and at play. Residents appreciate having an additional service on site that allows them to conveniently achieve their sustainability goals.

How can my property participate?

WM would be happy to have your property participate in the WM Textile Recycling program. Review the criteria below and reach out if your property is interested:

- · Located in Snohomish County.
- · At least 100 units.
- Subscribed to recycling services with WM.
- Staffed by an onsite property manager or team who can monitor the container. If your property is eligible and you are interested in learning more, **contact us today!**

What happens if my property signs up to participate?

Once your property is signed up, the process is simple.

- A WM representative will visit with a property decision-maker to identify an appropriate location for the textile recycling cart. Ideally this would be in a covered location that can be easily monitored.
- · WM will deliver the new cart.
- WM representatives will assist the property manager with providing information and outreach to residents about the new program, delivering outreach materials, posting signs and supplying digital templates or graphics for electronic communications.
- Participating property managers must agree to monitor the container and a collection schedule will be put in place.
