

RECYCLING

Please do not bag. Place these items loose in your recycling cart. Recyclables should be empty, clean & loose.



Plastic Bottles & Containers



Clean Metal



Paper



Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard



Glass Bottles & Jars



Motor Oil & Cooking Oil

Seal uncontaminated oil in clear, screw top plastic jugs. Label jugs with name + address. Place next to recycling cart. Limit: 3 gallons per pickup, 10 gallons per year. Single family residents only.

Extra Recycling

Place extra recyclables in a bin or cardboard box at the curb next to your recycling cart. There is no charge for extra recycling.

Garbage Guidelines

- Bag all garbage.
- Double bag pet waste, pet litter, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust, and cold ashes.

Extra Garbage? Garbage charges are based on cart size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your cart with the lid closed. If your lid is open more than 6 inches, there will be an extra charge.

Bulky items such as mattresses, large appliances and building materials can be picked up by appointment. Contact us for information.

Annual On-Call Cleanup Program

ACCEPTABLE BULKY ITEMS:

- Your on-call clean-up includes:
- one cubic yard of household garbage and
 - up to two (2) large items

FURNITURE

Sofa couch (no sleeper sofas), sectional sofa, loveseat, futon, recliner, lounge chair, ottoman, mattress & box spring (set counts as 1 item), bed frame & rails (set counts as 1 item), dresser, bookcase, desk, end table or nightstand (set), coffee table, dining table & chairs (set counts as 1 item), small entertainment center, filing cabinet

MISCELLANEOUS

BBQ (remove propane tanks, charcoal, ashes)

Rug (roll the rug tightly so the bundle is no longer than 6 feet and no more than 12 inches round)

Hot tub cover (only)

Ladder (6-foot limit)

Large plastic play toy & outdoor kiddie pool

Wheelbarrow

Microwave

Canopy (outdoor type pop-up or metal frame and no longer than 6 feet in length and 3 feet in diameter)

Vacuum cleaner

Child car seat or stroller

Artificial Christmas tree

Appliances are not accepted.

RESTRICTIONS / REQUIREMENTS

- No single item may weigh more than 60 pounds.
- Limited to 8' in length and free of liquids, including oils and fuel.
- Please tape/tie closed any cords, etc. for easy handling.

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Please follow these guidelines to ensure collection.

Please place carts at the curb by 6 am.

- Two (2) feet apart with lids opening toward street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences and utility boxes
- Wheels as close to the road as possible
- Please remove carts as soon as possible after collection
