All East Wenatchee residents have the option to choose from three garbage cart sizes. All sizes of garbage carts are serviced weekly and rates include recycling service.

Choose the garbage cart that works for you.

Why is my cart size so important?

All garbage must fit in your cart with the lid closed. Extra charges will apply for material left outside or on top of your cart.

Tips for Extra Garbage

- Garbage:** No loose garbage at the curb. Use a 32-gallon garbage can or bag tied at the top.
- Bulky Waste:** Bulky items such as mattresses and furniture can be picked up by special arrangement. Additional charges apply. [CALL US](#)
- Frequent Extras:** It may be less expensive to move up to the next larger garbage cart size or request an additional cart.

Bag Your Garbage

- Bag all garbage and place it in your grey garbage cart. In high wind areas, like East Wenatchee, it helps prevent fly away litter during collection.
- Double bag pet waste, pet litter, packing peanuts, vacuum dust, saw dust and cold ashes.

- Recycle clean, empty and loose, plastic bottles, cans, paper and cardboard.

- No glass!**
- No plastic bags or bagged recyclables!

Tips for Extra Recycling

- If your recyclables won't fit in your cart, hold some for next time!
- No bagged recycling
- Flatten cardboard

Extra Recyclables

For occasional extra recycling, use a cardboard box or personal can and label it "Recycle". No plastic bags accepted.

Collection Guidelines

Please place containers at the curb by 6 am October 1 to May 31 and by 5 am June 1 to September 30.

- Three (3) feet apart with lids open towards the street.
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees and mailboxes, fences and utility boxes.
- Remove containers as soon as possible after collection.
- During winter weather please place your carts where our trucks and drivers can safely access them.

Coloque los botes en la acera a las 6 am del 1 de octubre al 31 de mayo y a las 5 am del 1 de junio al 30 de septiembre.

- Tres (3) pies de distancia con las tapas abiertas hacia la calle.
- Al menos tres (3) pies de distancia de automóviles, árboles y buzones, cercas y cajas de servicios públicos.
- Durante el invierno, coloque sus botes donde nuestros camiones y conductores puedan acceder a ellos de manera segura.



Service Delays

If weather conditions prevent safe collection, up to twice as much material will be collected at no extra charge on your next regular collection day for each container not emptied. No credit for collection delayed due to weather.

Si las condiciones climáticas impiden una recolección segura, se recolectará hasta el doble de material sin cargo adicional en tu próximo día de recolección por cada bote no vaciado. No hay crédito por cobros retrasados debido al clima.

- Load limit is one level standard pickup truck bed, small utility trailers or car only (2.5 yards level load max). Loads over 2.5 yards will be charged standard rates.

Yard Debris

Redeem for disposal of residentially generated yard debris at no charge.

Accepted Items

- Cut Grass
- Leaves
- Plant Trimmings
- Branches (3" diameter and 4' long max)
- Wood Chips
- Christmas Trees

Prohibited Items

- Sod, Rocks and Dirt
- Tree Stumps
- Fake Christmas Trees, Flocked Trees or Ornaments

Garbage

Redeem for disposal of residentially generated garbage and bulky waste at no charge

Accepted Items

- Stoves
- Washers
- Dryers
- Dishwashers
- Water Heaters
- Doors & Windows
- Passenger car or motorcycle tires (limit 2)
- Toilets & sinks
- Computers/TV's (flat screens)
- Mattresses
- Gas Powered Equipment (drained of oil and fuel)
- Power Tools
- Small Appliances
- Household Junk

Prohibited Items

- Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners
- Automotive Waste
- All Automotive Fluids
- Car Batteries
- Asbestos containing material (drywall, carpet, roofing, etc.)
- Concrete
- Asphalt
- Insulation
- Dirt
- Hazardous Waste
- Any Liquid

Resources Beyond the Curb

Some items such as medical wastes, fluorescent bulbs and tubes, needles, fuel tanks, electronics and chemicals are hazardous and are not allowed in the garbage and recycling.
