DO NOT BAG RECYCLABLES. PLACE LOOSE IN CART.

Clean paper & cardboard



Metal



Glass bottles & jars

No caps or lids



Plastic bottles, cups, jugs & tubs

No caps or lids | No colored party cups



Extra Recycling :

Put extra recycling in cardboard boxes (limit 3'x3'x3'), or a 35-gallon can with handles marked "recycling".

Recycling Tips:

1. Ignore the number on plastic containers, instead recycle only plastics in the shape of a bottle, cup, jug or tub.
2. Empty, clean, and loose. These three words can greatly improve the quality of recyclables placed in your cart. You can do this by rinsing out recyclables and placing empty containers directly in your cart loose.
