

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Please follow these collection guidelines.

Please place carts at the curb by 6 am

- Two (2) feet apart with lids opening toward street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences and utility boxes
- Wheels as close to the curb as possible
- Remove carts as soon as possible after collection



GARBAGE

There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your cart with the lid closed.

- **Weight limit 35-gallon cart, 65-pounds** for your collector's safety.
- **Bag garbage.** Shopping bags works well.
- **Double bag** pet litter, packing pellets, cold ashes and any dusty material.



HAZARDOUS WASTE

Items such as fluorescent bulbs and tubes, loose needles, fuel tanks, computers and TVs are not allowed in garbage or recycling.
