

# RECYCLING

Please do not bag. Place these loose items in your recycling cart. Recyclables should be empty, clean and loose.



**Plastic Bottles, Cups & Jugs**  
(No colored party cups)

**Food & Beverage Cans**



**Glass Bottles & Jars**



**Flattened Cardboard, Paperboard & Paper**

**NO PLASTIC BAGS!**



**When in doubt, throw it out.**

**ONLY listed items should go in your recycle bin.**

## Recycling Tips:

Recycling is collected every other week. To determine if your collection occurs on a blue or yellow week, refer to the map.

Put extra recyclables in a bin, kraft paper bag or cardboard box. Please label "Recycle".



# COLLECTION GUIDELINES

YOUR RECYCLING CART WILL BE COLLECTED EVERY-OTHER WEEK ON YOUR GARBAGE COLLECTION DAY

Please follow these guidelines to ensure collection.

## Place carts at curb the night before your service day.

- Place carts three (3) feet apart with lids opening toward street.
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences, basketball hoops, and utility boxes.
- Remove containers as soon as possible after collection.
- Keep sidewalks clear for safety.
