RECYCLING TIPS

- Blue 96-gal recycling carts are emptied every-other-week (see enclosed calendar).
- All recycling must fit in your cart with the lid closed. For occasional extra recycling, use a cardboard box or personal can and label it "Recycle". No plastic bags accepted. Additional recycle carts are also available for an extra charge.
- Help ensure recyclables have a second life by **ONLY** putting recyclables pictured on this guide in your recycle cart. Non-recyclables items in your cart may be subject to a contamination charge.
