Food scraps and leftovers

No produce stickers



Food-soiled paper



Plants, flowers and yard trimmings

Branches must be no larger than 4 inches in diameter and cut into 4 foot or smaller sections.



Extra Yard and Food Debris:

There is a charge for extra yard debris that doesn't fit in your container with the lid closed.

Place extras in:

- Cans with handles labeled "Yard Debris" (32 gal., 64 lb. limit)
- Bundle tied with compostable twine (4'x2', 55 lb. limit)
- Kraft Paper bags labeled "Yard Debris"
- An extra cart (available for an extra charge)

Yard and Food Debris Collection Tips:

1. Collect kitchen food scraps in:
 - Colander or strainer
 - Paper grocery bag
 - Resuable plastic, metal or ceramic containers with a lid
2. Empty your container into yard and food debris cart frequently.
3. Layer food scraps with yard debris or newspaper to absorb liquids.
