

RECYCLING GUIDE

All items must be **clean, empty and placed loose** in the recycle cart. Recycle only these items.



Plastic Bottles, Jugs, Jars & Dairy Tubs
No lids



Food & Beverage Cans
No loose lids



Paper, Flattened Cardboard & Paperboard



Glass Bottles & Jars
No lids

Extra Recycling

There is no charge for extra recycling.

Place additional recyclables in a container that protects material from loss or weather conditions, and set out on the normal collection day, at no extra charge.

If you often have extra recyclables, upgrade to a larger 96-gallon cart at no additional cost or add a second cart for a reduced rate.

Extra Yard Waste

*There is a charge for extra yard waste.
Food waste must go in provided cart.*

Put extra yard trimmings in:

- **Cans with handles** (35 gal., 70 lb. limit)
 - Label cans "Yard Waste"
 - Put next to yard cart at least 2 ft. from garbage.
- **Kraft paper yard bags**
- **Bundles** (4x2x2 ft. limit)
- Extra yard waste is \$2.90 per additional 35 gal. bag, can, or unit.

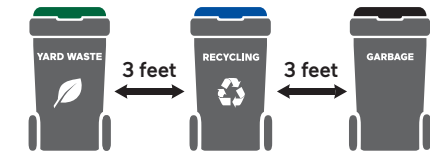

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Please follow these guidelines to ensure collection.

Place carts at the curb by 6 am.

- Three (3) feet apart with lids opening toward street
- At least three (3) feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences and utility boxes
- Wheels as close to the curb as possible
- Please remove carts as soon as possible after collection



GARBAGE

Charges are based on cart size. There is a charge for extra garbage that doesn't fit in your cart with the lid completely closed.

- Weight limit 35-gallon/60 lbs for your collector's safety
- Bag and tie garbage. Shopping bags work well
- Double bag pet litter, packing pellets and cold ashes

INCLEMENT WEATHER GUIDELINES

- Up to twice the regular amount of garbage, recycling, and compost will be collected at no additional charge on your next regularly scheduled collection day. Please note recycle and compost are collected every other week.
- In the event of two successive weather delays, make-up collection will be made on the next possible day.
- Credits are not issued for delayed collection due to inclement weather.
