Garbage Guidelines

- Prevent fires – no hot materials, batteries or chemicals.
- Double bag pet waste, pet litter, packing pellets, vacuum dust, sawdust and cold ashes.
- Garbage must be bagged in a WM-provided cart with the lid closed.

FALL LEAF COLLECTION

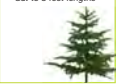
Leaves are collected during the first full calendar week (M-F) of November, December, and January. Put leaves in black plastic bags or kraft lawn bags and place them next to your cart on collection day. Each bag may not exceed 55 pounds. **There is no extra charge for this leaf service.**



CHRISTMAS TREES

will be collected the first two weeks of each year at no charge from single-family accounts.

- No flocking
- Cut to 3 feet lengths

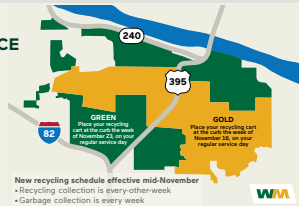

COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Please follow these rules and guidelines to help ensure seamless collections.

Place carts at curb the night before but no later than 5 am on your collection day.

- Place carts three feet apart with lids opening toward street.
- At least three feet from cars, trees, mailboxes, fences, basketball hoops, and utility boxes.
- Remove carts as soon as possible after collection.



RECYCLE BATTERIES SAFELY IN KENNEWICK

Batteries do not belong in your recycling or garbage cart. They can cause fires in collection vehicles and recycling facilities.

Rechargeable batteries, including NiCd, NiMH, lithium-ion, and other battery types, should be recycled properly and never placed in curbside collection.

For battery recycling locations and disposal options, visit bentoncountywa.gov and search for "batteries." Help keep employees, equipment, and the community safe by recycling batteries properly.

FREE DISPOSAL PROGRAM

For those times when you have more waste than your garbage cart can handle, the City of Kennewick's Free Disposal Program is your solution.

- Only available to active WM residential customers who live within the City of Kennewick.
- No commercial or multifamily account waste accepted.
- Loads are limited to 2.5 yard per visit, charges may apply to extra materials. A level loaded 8-foot truck bed is about 2.5 yards.
- State law requires all loads be covered during transport.
- Six trips per calendar year (Jan - Dec)

- Non-reusable household junk
- Washers and dryers
- Water heaters
- Stoves
- Dishwashers
- Small appliances
- Lawn mowers (no fuel/oil)
- Tires (limit 2)
- Furniture
- Doors, door frames, windows
- Toilets and sinks
- Mattresses (limit 1 per trip)
- Power tools (no batteries)
- Yard debris

ACCEPTED RECYCLING:

- Computers and TVs
- Motor oil
- Mixed paper
- Cardboard
- Plastic bottles
- Metal cans



ACCEPTED FOR A CHARGE:

(not part of disposal program)

- Concrete
- Dry wall
- Refrigerators, freezers, AC's
- Roofing
- Insulation
- All types of flooring
- Tree stumps (18" limit)
- Lumber, wood, treated wood
- Construction/demolition material
- Asphalt
- Masonry
- Siding
- Structural metal
- Dirt, rocks, sand, or in-fill



PROHIBITED:

- Running gears
- Thermometers
- Mercury switches
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Thermostats
- Car body parts
- All batteries
- Hazardous waste
- Paint
- Medical waste
- Commercially generated waste
