



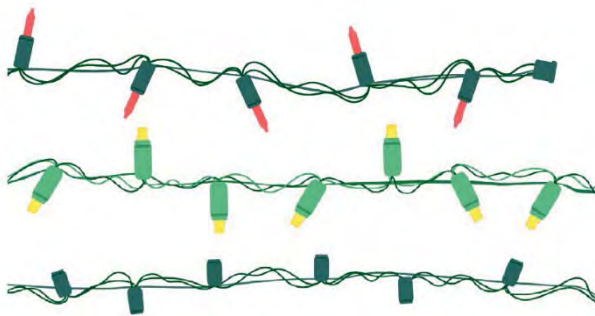
Special collection: October 1 – December 31, 2026

Hello Recycle+ Customer,

Your Recycle+ service includes special rotating collection items for reuse or recycling each quarter. **String lights** are the next featured item for recycling.

Include:

Small string lights, LED string lights and strings without lights.



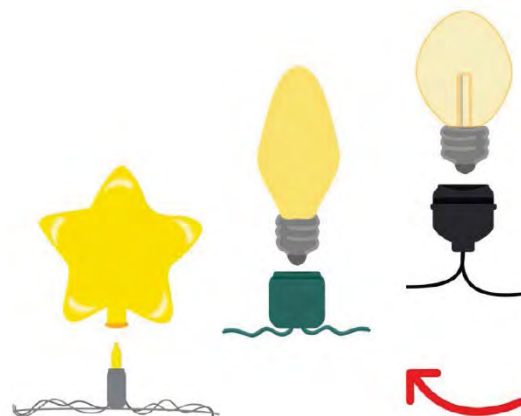
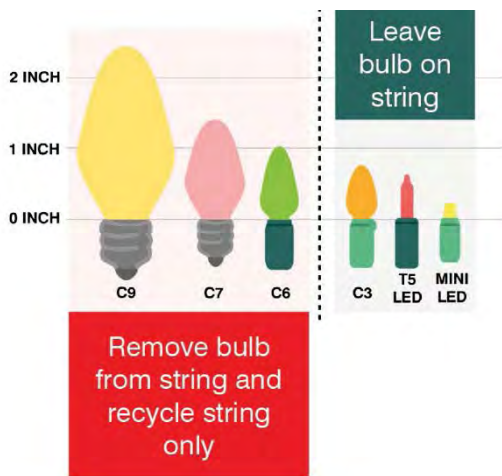
Don't Include:

Rope lights, novelty lights where the bulb cannot be removed, yard figures or other decor.



Prepare Lights

Remove novelty and larger bulbs, often identified as C6, C7 or C9. These are commonly found on lights that are older or for outdoor use. Removed bulbs can be put in the garbage or saved as replacement bulbs for your other string lights.

Thank you for recycling

The PVC plastic, copper wire and other metals from your broken string lights will be used to make new products like wires or pipes. The plastic will be made into many new products; it may end up as the soles of your next pair of slippers.

Prepare items for collection

- Separate Recycle+ collection materials by type.
- Put the materials in the plastic bags provided.
- Place the bags in the purple bin.
- Container lid must close completely to keep materials dry.

Schedule a pickup

- Request a pickup at least two business days before your regular Recycle+ collection day.

Set out your bin

- Your bag can be set in your Recycle+ bin. If your bin is full, place your extra bags to the side for \$1.25 each, up to 5 extra bags per pickup.
- Always put the lid on the bin.



Starting January 1, 2027 rotating items will be folded into the Recycle Plus standard program.
