Unlimited Recycling

Businesses and Multifamily Properties have unlimited recycling included in the cost of their garbage service. As needed, businesses and multifamily properties can increase the size of their dumpsters at no extra cost.

MULTIFAMILY PROPERTIES

WM Think Green Move In/Out Crew

A convenient on-call solution for property managers to clean up materials left behind by tenants during move in and move out. Property managers are welcome to call to schedule a pick-up. This new program also includes mattress recycling! Let WM lend a hand in the moving process.

WM ReTRN Program

(Recovering Textiles Right Now!)



This program offers large multifamily properties on-site textile collection. The containers can be located conveniently inside a common indoor space where residents can drop off textiles for donation and recycling. Once the container has been filled, the property manager simply emails WM to schedule collection.

Bulky Waste Collection

WM provides on-call bulky waste collection for multifamily properties for a fee. Property managers can simply contact WM customer service to schedule a bulky item pick up. Place your bulky item at your regular garbage collection location within 24-hours prior to collection.



WHAT DO I DO WITH...?

Hazardous Waste



If the label includes words such as danger, poison, caution, or toxic, it's likely hazardous waste and needs special disposal at drop-off locations.

Your business may be eligible for no-fee hazardous waste disposal up to four times a year. To qualify, your business must be a Small Quantity Generator, meaning you produce and store only a small quantity of hazardous material. Call 206-296-4692 or visit kingcountyhazwastewa.gov.

Fluorescent bulbs/tubes + HID's

Recycle up to 10 mercury-containing bulbs and tubes daily for free through LightRecycle (lightrecycle.org). LEDs and incandescents can go in the garbage.



Options for paint recycling

Latex and oil-based paint can now be recycled through a statewide program. Visit paintcare.org/WA for details and limits, and to find locations near you.



Electronics

Computers, monitors, TVs + tablets

Recycle computers, tablets, e-readers, monitors, TVs, and laptops for free by dropping off at an E-Cycle Washington location (ecyclewa.org).
